

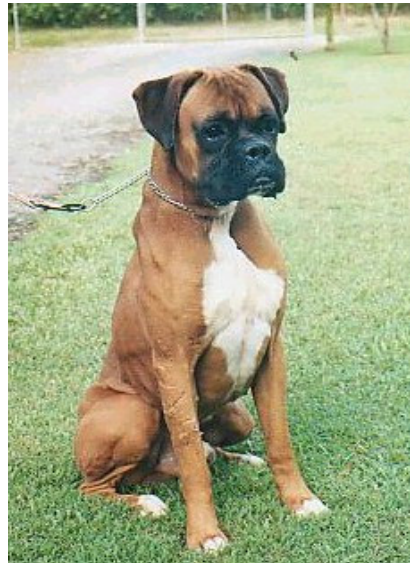

Old dogs, young dogs, neglected dogs, pre-loved dogs. You can get all types come through Boxer Rescue. Sometimes a person's home situation makes it impossible to keep their Boxer with them. We have had a couple of dogs come through where their elderly owners had to go into aged care facilities. The promise of a wonderful home with a loving new family makes the transition easier for both dog and former owner. Unfortunately we also get Boxers that have been abandoned by their owners - mostly we don't know the reasons. Sometimes they have been sick, sometimes they are "too old", sometimes the owners just don't want them anymore. These special rescues require special new families.

We in the Boxer community feel a duty and responsibility to help Boxers in need. And as Boxer lovers we want to find them the best homes we possibly can. We have helpers all over the state helping with Rescue. They work with the pounds, shelters & local vets to make sure no Boxers slip unnoticed through the system. They take them into their homes and care for them until transfer to their new family



All Boxers that come into the rescue kennels are vet checked, wormed, vaccinated, desexed and temperament tested. And all families on our waiting lists are carefully screened to make sure that the right Boxer is put into the right family situation - we don't want to see the Boxers back in rescue again.



We love to keep in contact with our rescue families and often find that they will rescue more than one dog - rescue Boxers are addictive. It's heartwarming to see our rescues joining in at our Fun Days or Pet Expo proving they have become valuable members of their new families.
